Shark Robe Cutting Guide by Crazy Little Projects

(These images are not necessarily to scale in relation to each other. They are just for guidance on the shape to cut.)

Cut a slanting neck on the line here: ---->

Front Piece: Cut 2

Width from side to side= 10 inches

Length from highest tip (top left) = 20.5"

The arm openings should be about 8-9 inches long when you measure along the curve.

Lay this one on top of the back piece to make sure it matches up in the length and the arm holes and neck. Arm openings --->

Back Piece: Cut 1

Width from side to side= 15 inches

Length from center of the top to the bottom=19 inches.

The arm openings should be about 8-9 inches long when you measure along the curve.

Tip

Belt-Cut 1 about 4 inches by 45"

Hood: Cut 1

16 inches wide by 14 inches high

Sleeve: Cut 2

Sleeve should be about 14-15 inches long (this is flexible because you can roll the sleeves at the bottom.)

Tip

The top curve should be about 18 inches when measured from one tip, up around the curve and to the other tip.)
