









Backpack Pieces: Main Fabric

Side Panel: Cut 1

4.5" x 30"

Zipper Panel: Cut 2

2.5" x 17"

Inner Front and Back:

Cut 2

14 1/2" by 12 1/2"

Interfacing Pieces: Optional but recommended if you are using a light weight fabric. These will give it more sturdiness. If possible use fusible interfacing and adhere these to the coordinating pieces in the main fabric. Otherwise baste them in place.
